Completing the Draft Plan – Scenario 1

If RBC elects to vote on the newest proposed recommendations, using the same process as was followed for the five policy, legislative, and regulatory issues summarized in Chapter 9, then:

- On 12/15, John will send a Google survey to RBC
- By 12/19, RBC responds to survey with vote
- By 12/22, John will update Ch 9 with survey results, and other agreed to edits discussed today, and send the Draft Plan to RBC.
- By 12/31, RBC provides their level of endorsement on the Draft Plan
- Finalize and release Draft Plan the week of Jan 2.
- Schedule 1st public meeting for the week of Feb 7, 8 or 9.

Completing the Draft Plan – Scenario 2

If RBC reaches consensus (today) on the proposed recommendations, then:

- By 12/22, John will update Ch 9 with survey results, and other agreed to edits discussed today, and send the Draft Plan to RBC.
- By 12/31, RBC provides their level of endorsement on the Draft Plan
- Finalize and release Draft Plan the week of Jan 2.
- Schedule 1st public meeting for the week of Feb 7, 8 or 9.
