Thank you for your interest and/or comments regarding the application from the above referenced facility for an air quality permit to construct and operate a new greenfield limestone quarry and 600 tons per hour processing plant. Be advised that South Carolina Department of Environmental Services ("SCDES") has made a decision regarding the permit after consideration and complete review of the following: the permit application, applicable state and federal air quality regulations, comments made at the public hearing held on February 8, 2024, all comments received within the required time frame, the public hearing transcripts, and all other pertinent information. All comments received were reviewed for technical merit and have been included in SCDES's permanent record for this facility. SCDES's decision is to approve the above referenced permit for issuance on August 15, 2024.
