Re: Notice of SCDES Department Decision on Air Quality General Construction Permit for Concrete Plants
Statewide, South Carolina

Dear Concerned Citizen,

Thank you for your interest and/or comments regarding the renewal of an air quality general construction permit for concrete plants to cover facilities that have similar operations. Be advised that South Carolina Department of Environmental Services ("SCDES") has made a decision regarding the permit after consideration and complete review of the following: applicable state and federal air quality regulations, comments made at the public hearing held on February 26, 2026, all comments received within the required time frame, the public hearing transcripts, and all other pertinent information. All comments received were reviewed for technical merit and have been included in SCDES's permanent record for this facility. SCDES's decision is to approve the above referenced permit for issuance on April 1, 2026.

Please note that this permitting action renders no decision regarding any specific application for coverage under the terms of the general construction permit for concrete plants.

S.C Code Ann. § 48-6-30(D)(2) provides: "Within thirty calendar days after the mailing of a decision [pursuant to S.C. Code Ann.§ 48-6-30(D)(1)], an applicant, permittee, licensee, certificate holder, or affected person desiring to contest the department decision may request a contested case hearing before the Administrative Law Court, in accordance with the Administrative Procedures Act."
