Submitting an "Air - Source Test Submission" Package


Source Evaluation has streamlined it's ePermitting process for the submittal of stack testing related documents. This new process, "Submission Packages" will allow for multiple compliance forms to be submitted and "Approved" individually within the package. Think of the "Package" as the overall testing event and the forms (notification, test plans, etc.) are contained in it. We will be able to approve the individual forms and then the package at the end.

This will allow our customers to know the status of their forms more quickly and hopefully eliminate some confusion.


Each submission package must be submitted for each testing event. Please remember that you must submit forms in the correct submission package. **Do not** start a new one.

The following guide provides a step-by-step process for submitting an "Air – Source Test Submission Package".


Navigate to your ePermitting home page for your facility.




1. Click on arrow to get a list of your sites.




2. Choose the site you wish to submit the source test information. Make sure you are under the site with the "Air" permit(s) for your facility.




3. Click "Start a New Form"




4. Click "I want to make a service request"




Use the filter or scroll to locate the "Air Source Test Information" form. Click "View Package"




6. Once in the "Air – Source Test Submission Package", click "Begin"




7. A window will appear, make sure the correct site is listed under "Select Site". If not choose from dropdown. Click select.




8. Click "Begin Form Entry"




9. Fill in the fields for "Site Name" and "Permit Number".




10. Fill in the information for "Testing Contact." This will be the person responsible at your facility during the stack test.




11. Click "Yes" to enter the information for an "additional testing contact" person. Click "No" if there is only one "testing contact".




12. Click "Next Section Test Information"




13. Fill out the fields to indicate what sources are being tested. Please make sure to enter the source information as it is listed within your permit.




14. Click to indicate whether the source test is a CEMS/COMS audit.




15. Click all the applicable regulations this source test is for.




16. For each selected "Applicable Regulation" box, a drop-down menu will appear.




17. Under each drop-down menu, select the correct regulations this test will cover.




18. Click the applicable regulations.




19. Click "Test Type (Select all applicable for this source)". Select what kind of testing is going to take place.




20. Click "Pollutant (Select all applicable for this source)".




21. Select which pollutant(s) are going to be tested for.




22. Click the "Optional: Additional information about the Test Type / Pollutant(s)" field, if additional information needs to be added.




23. If you have another unit or different test taking place during this testing event, please click "Add New Test Information." Repeat the previous steps listed.




24. Once all the test information fields have been completed, click "Review".




25. Review the information for accuracy. Once complete, click "Next Section Certify & Submit".




26. Click "Finalize submission: Submit Form".




27. Click "Return to ePermitting Home".




28. The "Air – Source Test Information" form will now show as "Staged" and the "Air – Source Test Submission Package" is in "Draft" status. Click "Submit Package".



- 29. Click "Agree and Submit" to submit the "Air Source Test Submission Package" to the Department.
- **We cannot review any part of the submission package until it has been submitted. Your regulatory submittal requirements are not satisfied without submitting it. **



30. Once the "Air – Source Test Submission Package" is submitted. The status of the package will change from "Draft" to "In Process".



The "Air – Source Test Submission Package" is now submitted. Now you can submit any of the following forms to Source Evaluation within the package:

- Air- Source Test Notification(s)
 - o Submit an initial testing notification
 - Request change of test date (i.e.: test date changes from original notification date)
 - Request test date extension (i.e.: if the originally established or regulatory required test date cannot be met, this notification will be needed)
- Air Source Test Plan
- Air Source Test Report
