It's the law. That's right, it must be recycled. If you have your oil changed at a car dealership, garage or quick lube, your used motor oil is recycled by that business. If you change your own oil, you must recycle it.

Where can you recycle your used motor oil, bottles and filters?



The City of Sumter provides the **used motor oil** collection drop-off site listed below for its residents.

- **303 East Liberty Street**

It is located at the rear of the City Complex and is open Monday through Friday 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Sumter County also provides nine recycling drop-off sites that collect **used motor oil, bottles and filters** at these locations.
