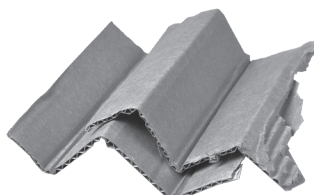


Draw a line from each word on the left to the phrase that best describes it.

<b>Trash</b>	To find a new use for something instead of throwing it away.
<b>Litter</b>	A recyclable material made from trees.
<b>Reuse</b>	To buy less and to throw away less trash.
<b>Reduce</b>	To stop purchasing an item in a container or package that is not recyclable.
<b>Natural Resources</b>	Leaves and grass trimmings that are broken down by natural processes and can be used on gardens.
<b>Landfill</b>	Our garbage – all the things we throw away.
<b>Recycling</b>	Trash that is in the wrong place such as on the ground or in the street.
<b>Paper</b>	A process that makes something new out of something old.
<b>Reject</b>	A place where trash is buried.
<b>Compost</b>	Things that are found in nature that we must have to live.
