

## **Common Hazardous Household Products**

Many of the items we use every day can become a problem if they are used, stored or disposed of improperly. Products are considered hazardous – that is, harmful to human health and the environment – if they have one or more of the following properties - FLAMMABLE, TOXIC, CORROSIVE AND EXPLOSIVE/REACTIVE.

**DIRECTIONS:** Place an **F** if the object is flammable, **T** if it is toxic, **C** if it is corrosive or **E** if it is explosive/reactive. Some items may have more than one letter. One item has no letters.
