

Dear Ms. Adamowitz-Murphy,

The Department has reviewed the referenced document and offers the following comments:

1. Progress has been made with the delineation of the plumes during this phase of work, however, some data gaps remain. Specifically, further delineation is needed in the shallow aquifer west of monitoring well MW-12.
2. In the intermediate groundwater zone, further assessment is needed between monitoring wells MW-24I and MW-21I; and northeast and northwest of MW-101 on the Dickert Property.
3. Further assessment is also needed in the bedrock zone between RDW-1 and PW-4, northeast of 18D, and between PW-2 and PW-1.

As the geology at the site is very complicated and changes greatly over a short distance, the Department suggests generating a 3-D model of the plumes to review, prior to submitting a work plan for the above assessment. This should aid in placement of any additional wells. Please submit this 3-D representation, to my attention, on or before July 22, 2016. Further action will be discussed after review of this submittal.
