The Non-Permitted Petroleum release #1 was reported on August 20, 2021 after a Phase II assessment was completed by S.C. Department of Transportation. Historical records indicate that the property just north of the investigated area (Parcel 054-00-00-081-000) is associated with an unregistered pre-1974 Underground Storage Tank (UST). First-hand statements taken from a previous owner, a neighbor, and the contractor for SCDOT support this claim. It is requested that the Regulatory Section conduct an investigation.

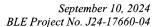

Pertaining to Calls on 5/23/24

Call to Mr. T Carrol Atkinson: Mr. Atkinson called back and needed to make corrections to his statement. He and his brother did confirm that they sold gas at that location. They were only selling it to one customer at the time and stopped when the delivery truck "stuck em" and never took a delivery since. They jointly purchased the property with their friend, James Skipper (d. 2021) in either 1971 or 1972. He confirmed that they ceased selling gas prior to the sale of the property in 1978. He remembered that it was locally known as "The Long Branch". He confirm that he never saw tanks above the ground (ASTs) and only took deliveries into the tank underground (UST). They had two dispensers under a canopy.

Call to Ms. Elaine Berkely: Ms. Berkley returned the call regarding the statement. After re-reading her statement, she made the correction of "gas tank" to "gas pumps" and confirmed that she never saw tanks above the ground. She doesn't remember any cylinder tanks being on that property. She knows that Mr. Atkinson sold the property in 78, but does not remember exactly when it closed. She thinks it was around the time that Mr. Charlie Moore (father to the current PO) took over the store. She said that the store was located " on the back road to Mullins" or another name could have been Lake View highway into Smithboro.





Report of Groundwater Sampling Event Marion Roundabout; Site ID #18842

1.0 PROJECT INFORMATION

The following project information was obtained through a *Phase I Environmental Site Assessment, Marion Roundabout*, prepared by BLE, dated April 20, 2022.

On-Site Findings

The Site totals approximately 1.30-acres and is developed as a SCDOT roundabout located at the intersection of Metal Street, Jones Avenue, and Senator Gasque Road in Marion, Marion County, South Carolina. The roundabout is located approximately 1 mile northeast of downtown Marion, South Carolina.

At the time of the March 24, 2022 Site reconnaissance, the Site consisted of the SCDOT roundabout, which includes an asphalt roadway, concrete curbing, and landscaped lawn.

BLE did not identify any on-Site Recognized Environmental Conditions (RECs) during the Phase I ESA.

Off-Site Findings

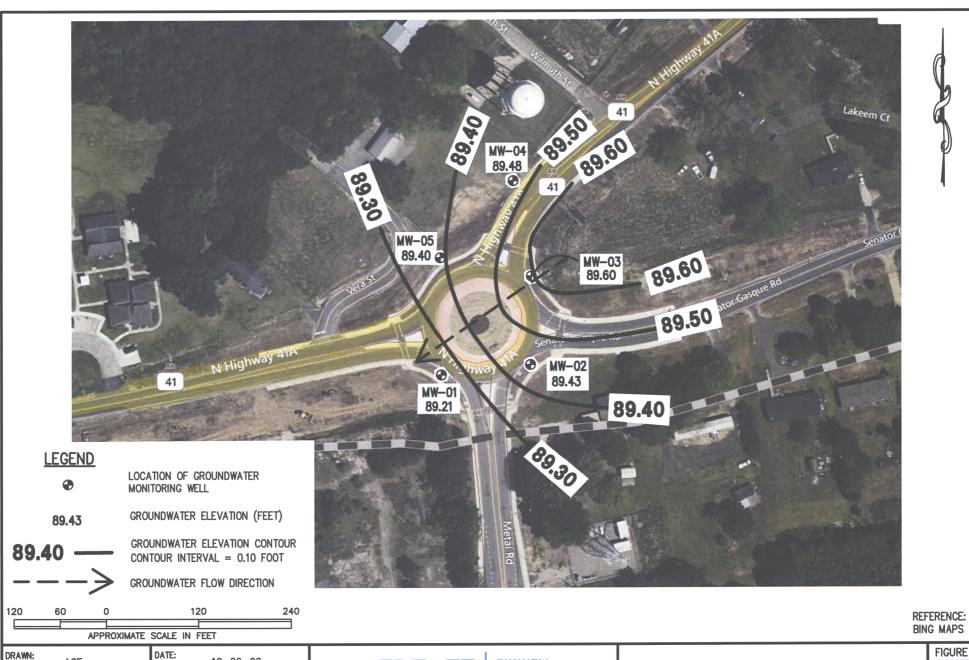
The Site is located in an area that generally consists of residential and commercial developments. Commercial structures and the City of Marion municipal water tower are located north of the Site. Senator Gasque Road, followed by single-family residences, are located east of the Site. Metal Street, followed by single-family residences, is located south of the Site. Jones Avenue, followed by a multi-family residential development, is located west of the Site.

During the Phase I ESA, BLE identified the following off-Site REC:

• A suspected former gas station and associated underground storage tank (UST) system was identified on the adjoining property north of the Site. While SCDES did not have any record of a nearby registered UST system, a suspected former fuel dispenser island was identified during the Phase I ESA. The suspected former gas station is inferred to be up-gradient of the Site. BLE considered the suspected former gas station and associated UST system a REC to the Site.

In response to the findings of the Phase I ESA, a Limited Phase II ESA was performed at the request of the SCDES. The Limited Phase II ESA included the installation and sampling of five (5) temporary groundwater monitoring wells encompassing the roundabout intersection. The results of the Limited Phase II ESA indicated chemicals of concern (CoC) concentrations above South Carolina established Risk-Based Screening Levels (RBSLs) in the area adjacent to the suspected former gas station and associated UST system. Details and results of the Limited Phase II ESA are documented in the *Limited Phase II Environmental Site Assessment* report by BLE, dated December 12, 2022.

In an effort to further assess the extent of the contamination plume, the SCDES requested an additional assessment, including the installation and sampling of one (1) permanent groundwater monitoring well, designated MW-06, in the area of concern from the Phase I ESA. Details and results of the additional assessment are documented in the *Report of Additional Assessment* by BLE, dated September 28, 2023.

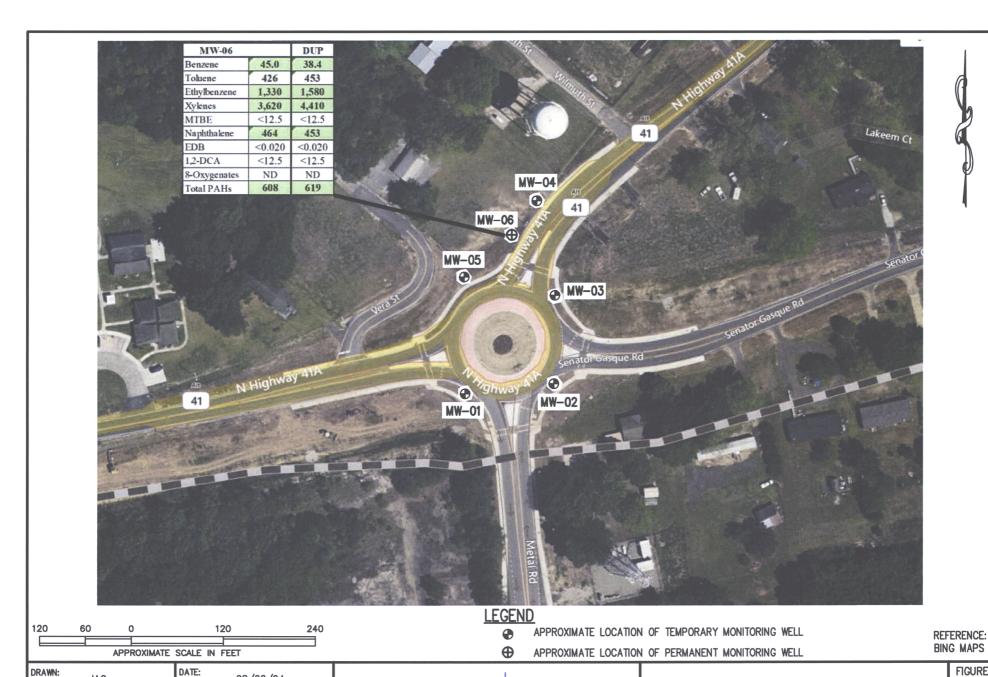

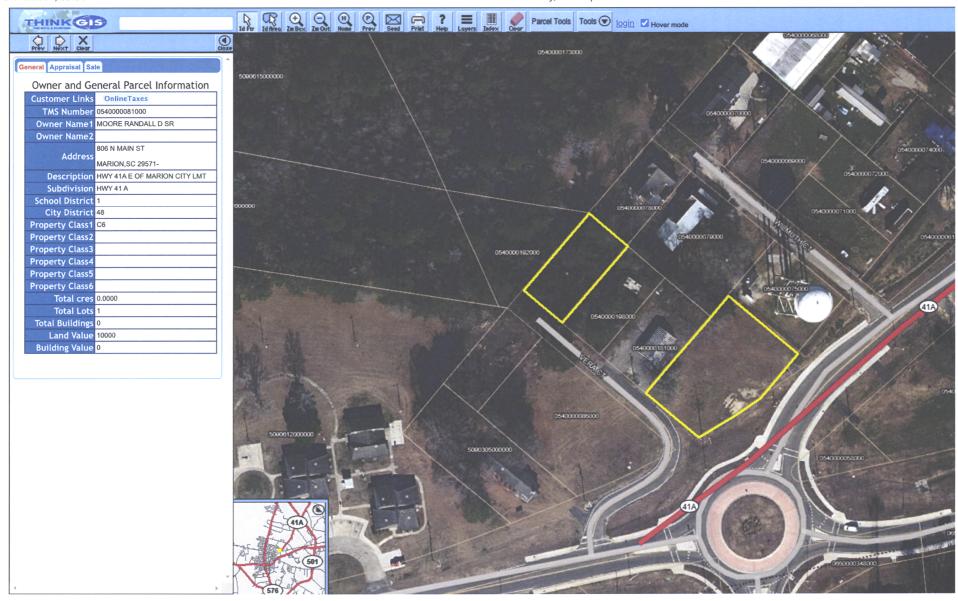
