On behalf of Products (SE) Pipe Line Corporation (PPL), Jacobs has prepared this response to the Monitoring Well Installation Approval and Notice to Proceed letter received from the South Carolina Department of Environmental Services (SCDES) in a letter date-stamped August 5, 2024 for the Lewis Drive Remediation Site (Site ID #18693), located in Belton, South Carolina.

In the letter received from SCDES an assessment report was requested to be submitted on or before November 1, 2024 to present the results of the assessment and well installations. Per previous conversations about reporting requirements in our regularly scheduled meetings, to streamline DES's review process, rather than submit a stand-alone report, Jacobs will include a summary of work activities of the three newly installed observation wells within the Second 2024 Semiannual Monitoring and System Operation and Maintenance Report to SCDES on or before March 31, 2025.
