Re: **Variance: Emergency fuel deliveries at facilities under delivery prohibition for a 10-day period due to Hurricane Helene**

In preparation for the possible impacts for Hurricane Helene, the UST Management Division recognizes that there may be UST facilities in South Carolina that can safely provide fuel to residents; but are unable to receive fuel deliveries due to unresolved violations and the implementation of delivery prohibition. Each facility was evaluated to determine the nature of the violations and determine if they could operate for a period of ten (10) days and maintain release prevention and release detection effectively. On September 26, 2024, each facility identified in this memo can remove the red tag and accept delivery of fuel. These facilities will be temporarily removed from the delivery prohibition web site. Please retain this memo for proof of permission to receive deliveries. Also, temporary certificates will be forwarded to facilities with outstanding fees. On October 7, 2024, all facilities identified in this memorandum will again be subject to the conditions of delivery prohibition and unable to receive fuel deliveries. This memo does not release owners/operators from the responsibility to comply with the SC UST Regulations and resolve all outstanding violations.
