Meeting Summary (June 25th)

JD Solomon, Pee Dee River Basin Council Facilitator, called the June 25th meeting of the Pee Dee RBC to order at 9:00 AM. The twenty-fifth meeting of the Pee Dee RBC was held virtually via the Zoom virtual meeting platform. Including the Pee Dee RBC members and planning team, there were 29 people present at this RBC meeting.

JD Solomon reviewed the agenda items for the meeting. The Pee Dee RBC approved the RBC meeting agenda and approved the minutes and summary documents from the May meeting. A public comment period was held with no comments. An agency public comment period was held with no comments.

The first item on the agenda was an update on the groundwater modeling work underway. Brad Harken, USGS, updated the Pee Dee RBC on the status of the model. The parent model is working and the USGS team are adjusting the model. The USGS team has had some big issues which they were able to get through and now have some additional minor issues to fix.

JD Solomon briefly discussed a summary of the prioritization results which included receiving remaining responses from a few RBC members who were not present at the May meeting. The results will be included in Chapter 7 of the river basin plan.

Matt Lindburg, Brown & Caldwell, led discussion on the status of chapters for the Pee Dee River Basin Plan. Chapters 1, 2, 3, 5 and 8 had already received preliminary approval. Chapter 6 was distributed to the Chapter 6 subcommittee which provided feedback. Chapter 6 will be distributed to the larger RBC ahead of the July meeting. Chapter 7 was getting close to draft form; it just needed some prior results to be incorporated. Chapter 9 will have what it needs after Chapter 7 is completed. Chapter 4 will be completed after the team pulls together surface water and groundwater demand projections. Chapter 10 will be the final chapter which has not been started.

JD Solomon asked for volunteers for Chapter 7 and Chapter 9 subcommittees to review the chapters before being distributed to the RBC.

The RBC then discussed the July Field Trip and meeting at Sonoco. The RBC will tour the Sonoco facility which will be followed by a brief meeting. JD Solomon and Buddy Richardson concluded the meeting at 9:43 AM. The next meeting of the Pee Dee RBC will be July 23, 2024 and will be a hybrid meeting after the Sonoco field trip.
