Meeting Summary (January 15th)

The Saluda RBC Vice Chair, Katherine Amidon, called the January 15th meeting of the Saluda RBC to order at 10:01 AM. The twenty-first meeting of the Saluda RBC was held in-person and virtually via the Zoom virtual meeting platform. Including the Saluda RBC members and planning team, there were 38 people present at this RBC meeting in-person and online. KC discussed the agenda items for the meeting. The Saluda RBC approved the RBC meeting agenda. The December minutes and summary documents were approved. A public comment period was held with no formal comments received. An agency comment period was held with no formal comments received.

John Boyer facilitated the final discussion and development of plan recommendations. The discussion and subsequent votes were on stormwater runoff BMPs, surface water law and regulation, and alignment with existing water plans. The RBC then moved on to the development of the implementation plan. The draft objectives for the implementation plan included: improve water use efficiency to conserve water resources, communicate, coordinate, and promote findings and recommendations from the River Basin Plan, improve technical understanding of water resource management issues, protect water resources, improve drought management, and promote engagement in the water planning process.

A brief update was given about WaterSC's previous meeting on January 7th. Additional information was presented about the Surface Water Study Committee appointees and an upcoming meeting of the committee.

The RBC meeting was adjourned. The next meeting of the Saluda RBC will be held February 19th at the LCWSC office in Laurens. Topics for the next meeting: development of progress metrics, review of RBC comments and edits to the draft river basin plan, review of executive summary, and first public meeting discussion.
