Meeting Summary (September 18th)

The Saluda RBC Chair, KC Price, called the September 18th meeting of the Saluda RBC to order at 10:03 AM. The seventeenth meeting of the Saluda RBC was held in-person and virtually via the Zoom virtual meeting platform. Including the Saluda RBC members and planning team, there were 41 people present at this RBC meeting in-person and online. KC discussed the agenda items for the meeting. The Saluda RBC approved the RBC meeting agenda. The August minutes and summary documents were approved. A public comment period was held with no formal comments received. An agency comment period was held with no formal comments received.

Kirk Westphal, CDM Smith, reviewed comments received regarding draft chapters 4 and 8 to the RBC members present. The RBC then continued discussion and development of RBC plan recommendations. Planning Process recommendation discussion focused on continued funding and building on resiliency planning efforts. Kirk reviewed green bucket recommendations and then continued discussion of technical recommendations from the August meeting. Technical recommendation discussion topics included discussion on groundwater resources and water quality. Finally, the Saluda RBC worked through policy, legislative and regulatory recommendations. Topics discussed during this part of the meeting included allocation of surface water resources, land/water management laws, regulations, policies, and manuals, and revisions of stormwater mitigation and groundwater recharge strategies.

The RBC meeting was adjourned. The next meeting of the Saluda RBC will be held October 30th at the LCWSC office in Laurens.
