To view GIS files using ArcGIS Earth

Step 1: Download and install the ArcGIS Earth software. Click 'Downloads'. Once it completes downloading, click on the .exe file (ArcGIS_Earth_Installer.exe) to install the software. The .exe file should be located in your Downloads folder. A dialog box may pop up and ask if you want to run this file. Click 'Run'. An install dialog box will walk you through the installation. Accept the default settings and keep clicking Next or Accept until you reach the end o


Step 2: Download the data from the Beachfront Jurisdictional Line application located at this link: https://gis.des.sc.gov/shoreline/. To do that, click on '**Downloads and Links**' in the upper right-hand corner and select the data of interest. This will download a compressed (zipped) folder. Unzip the folder. To unzip, locate the zipped folder in your Downloads folder, right click on the folder, and select 'Extract All' from the menu. You can either extract the files to your downloads folder (default) or select a different folder by clicking 'Browse'. Then click 'Extract'.

Step 3: Open the ArcGIS Earth program. It will prompt you to take a tour of the application. You can walk through the tutorial or click 'Skip'.

Step 4: Add Data. Click on the + symbol in the upper left to open and view the data you downloaded (outlined in yellow below).



Step 5: Click on 'Add Files'. Click on 'Select Files'.




Step 6: Navigate to your Downloads folder (or wherever you saved the extracted data) and open the data folder of interest. Select the data files you would like to add to the viewer. Once they are highlighted, Click 'Open'. The data will be added to the map and zoom to the South Carolina coast.

Step 7: To zoom in to a specific location, click the search icon (magnifying glass) in the upper right corner. Type in the location/address in the search box and click on the correct location from the drop down. You can also use your mouse to pan and zoom.

Step 8: To view additional data attributes, click on the point or line segment to view a popup of the attributes.

Step 9: To turn files on and off, click on the legend symbol (outline in red below), and use the check boxes to turn layers off/on.
