- For an existing site: If you are applying for a permit for a site that already exists and is linked to your account, be sure to select that existing site before moving forward.

Filling out the Form

- You can navigate through the form in two ways:
- 1. Click on the sections listed on the left-hand side to move

between the sections.

• 2. After completing a section and uploading any necessary

documents, scroll to the bottom and click 'Next Section' to proceed.

Submission Requirements

- Your submission requires an Excel file containing details on the proposed wells and specific information about them. It is essential to include a properly completed Excel sheet as part of the submission process.
- If a blank or incomplete Excel sheet is uploaded, the submission will be returned for corrections before it can be processed. Please ensure all required information is accurately provided to avoid delays.

Wet Ink Signatures

- This form requires a wet-ink signature due to EPA regulations.
- If you have not submitted your wet-ink signature to the Department, you must complete this form in its entirety.
 - <u>CROMERR-Certifier-Agreement.pdf</u>
- Once the Certifier Agreement Admin receives, reviews, and approves your completed form, you will be designated as an approved signer in ePermitting. Following this, the program must also grant approval at the site level before you can submit your form.
- Only after approval will you be able to submit this document.

Finalize Submission

- This final step allows you to certify the form as complete and accurate for submission to the department for review and processing.
- You can only finalize the submission if:
 - Your wet ink signature is on file.
 - The form is fully completed in its entirety.
- If both requirements are met, click the FINALIZE SUBMISSION Submit Form button to complete the process.
