

SUMMARY SHEET Enforcement Action Report October 2024

For the reporting period of September 1, 2024, through September 30, 2024, the Department of Environmental Services issued sixty-four (64) Consent Orders with total assessed civil penalties in the amount of three hundred seventy-one thousand, eight hundred fifteen dollars (\$371,815.00). Also, nine (9) Administrative Orders with total assessed civil penalties in the amount of twenty-six thousand, five hundred twenty-five dollars (\$26,525.00) were reported during this period.

<u>Summary</u>: Chetan and Manisha Patel (Individual/Entity) own underground storage tanks (USTs) in York County, South Carolina. On February 27, 2024, the Department conducted a file review of the Facility and issued a Notice of Alleged Violation. The Individual/Entity has violated the SUPERB Act and the South Carolina Underground Storage Tank Regulation, as follows: failed to inspect and impressed current system every sixty (60) days; failed to provide records to the Department upon request; failed to provide an adequate release detection method; failed to properly maintain release detection equipment; failed to test tank release detection equipment annually; failed to conduct proper release detection using an automatic tank gauge; failed to maintain records for at least one (1) year; and failed to maintain corrosion protection on a temporarily closed UST.

Action: The Individual/Entity is required to submit: either ten (10) of twelve (12) of the most recent automatic tank gauge records with the most recent two (2) months passing for all currently-in-use USTs at the Facility or passing current tank tightness test results and current passing automatic tank gauge results for all currently-in-use USTs at the Facility; proof the automatic tank gauge has been repaired and/or replaced and passing follow-up release detection equipment operability rest results; and proof a rectifier log has been initiated and is being properly maintained. The Department has assessed a total civil penalty

in the amount of fifteen thousand, five hundred twenty dollars (\$15,520.00). The Individual/Entity shall pay a civil penalty in the amount of fifteen thousand, five hundred twenty dollars (\$15,520.00).

The Individual/Entity has violated the SUPERB Act and the South Carolina Underground Storage Tank Regulation, as follows: failed to provide an adequate release detection method; failed to test release detection equipment annually; failed to conduct proper release detection using an automatic tank gauge; and failed to maintain records for at least one (1) year.

Action: The Individual/Entity is required to submit: either the most recent ten (10) of twelve (12) months of automatic tank gauge records with the most recent two (2) months passing for all USTs or current passing tank tightness test results and current passing automatic tank gauge records for all USTs at the Facility; and passing release detection equipment operability test results for all USTs at the Facility. The Department has assessed a total civil penalty in the amount of eight thousand, five dollars (\$8,005.00). The Individual/Entity shall pay a civil penalty in the amount of eight thousand, five dollars (\$8,005.00).

Action: The Individual/Entity is required to: submit a notarized UST Transfer of Ownership form (D3871); and a completed UST Tank and Sludge Disposal Form by November 1, 2024; within forty-five (45) days of the Department's approval of the UST Tank and Sludge Disposal Form, permanently close all USTs at the facility; and within sixty (60) days of the permanent closure of the USTs, submit and UST Closure and Assessment Report. Should the results of the UST Closure and Assessment Report indicate the presence of a release, submit a completed Certificate of Financial Responsibility form and evidence of financial assurance as directed by the Department. The Department has assessed a total civil penalty in the amount of fifty-two thousand, six hundred dollars (\$52,600.00). The Individual/Entity shall pay a civil penalty in the amount of three thousand, eight hundred fifty dollars (\$3,850.00) and pay a suspended penalty in the amount of forty-eight thousand, seven hundred fifty dollars (\$48,750.00) should any requirement of the Order not be met.

The Individual/Entity has violated the South Carolina Hazardous Waste Management Act, the Hazardous Waste Management Regulations as follows: failed to ensure universal waste aerosol cans were accumulated in a container that was structurally sound, compatible with the contents of the aerosol cans, lacks evidence of leakage, spillage, or damage that could cause leakage; failed to clearly label or mark universal waste aerosol cans (i.e., each aerosol can), or a container in which the aerosol cans are contained, with any of the following phrases: "Universal Waste—Aerosol Can(s)," "Waste Aerosol Can(s)," or "Used Aerosol Can(s)"; failed to clean up any hazardous waste discharge that occurred during generation, processing, or storage; failed to manage lamps in a way that prevents releases of any universal waste or component of a universal waste to the environment; failed to demonstrate the length of time that the universal waste had been accumulated from the date it becomes a waste or is received; failed to make an accurate determination if that waste was a hazardous waste; failed to ensure all containers holding hazardous waste were closed during accumulation; stored waste on site for more than one hundred eighty (180) days, without complying with the conditions for exemption for longer accumulation; failed to prepare a Manifest on EPA Form 8700-22, and, if necessary, EPA Form 8700-22A; failed to notify the Department no later than thirty (30) calendar days prior to initiating a planned episodic event using EPA Form 8700-12 or within seventy-two (72) hours of an unplanned episodic event via phone, email, or fax, and subsequently submit EPA form 8700-12; failed to maintain records documenting the arrangements with the local police department, fire department, other emergency response teams, emergency response contractors, equipment suppliers, and local hospitals, taking into account the types and quantities of hazardous wastes handled at the facility.

Action: The Individual/Entity is required to submit: analytical results (utilizing Toxicity Characteristic Leaching Procedure), with sampling including two (2) representative samples per waste stream and updated waste profiles for the sand blasting media collected outside the Wheelabrator Area to the Department. The Department has assessed a total civil penalty in the amount of seventeen thousand dollars (\$17,000.00).
