Dear Mr. Effinger:

In July of 2019, Dominion Energy provided a Permit Application Strategy to conduct a Modified Removal Action (MRA) to DHEC. The Permit Application Strategy was broken down into 5 major components: Riverside Operations, Landside Operations, "Completed" USACE Permit Application Submittal, MRA Work Plan, and Remediation Field Activities.

One of the key pieces for the MRA to move forward has been obtaining approval from the local floodplain coordinators for the "No-Rise Certification." As of today, the Flood Plain Coordinators have each approved the "No-Rise Certification."

During the extended time this task has taken to get approval, Dominion Energy has assured the Department that they have most of the other tasks identified as Riverside Operations and Landside Operations in place to move the MRA toward submittal to the USACOE. The Department requests Dominion Energy to submit to the Department a Revised Permit Application Strategy with a revised schedule by April 21, 2020. This Revised Permit Application Strategy should identify what tasks are left to be completed and their expected completion dates to get to a "Completed" USACOE Permit Application Submittal by June 30, 2020.
