

Dear Mr. Ard,

The Department has received and reviewed the referenced report and offers the following comments. Monitoring wells MW-18 and 18A were installed near the downgradient near the creek. The wells were non-detect for PCP which indicates that the contaminant plume is defined in the downgradient direction. In addition, water table levels indicated and an upward vertical head which demonstrates that the groundwater is discharging to the creek in this area. Wells BSW-1 and BSW-2 were installed for use in the bio-sparg pilot test. Please note, the well construction diagrams do not indicate the installation of a 2' X 2' pads to prevent surface water infiltration. Also, the groundwater pH's were not included in the report. Please forward upon receipt of this letter. In addition, what is the status of the two pilot tests? The Department approves the semi-annual sampling schedule. The last sampling was in January so June's sampling report should be submitted upon receipt of this letter.
