Dear Ms. Murtaugh:

The purpose of this letter is to follow up on the above referenced approval letter. Marsh Furniture Company chose S&ME to complete the outlined Scope of Work presented to you on October 30, 1998. Given holiday schedules, S&ME indicated they can mobilize a geoprobe the first week in January, 1999 to complete the work.

By completing the field work in the first week of January 1999, it is anticipated that analytical data will be back by February 1, 1999. Laboratories usually take 10 working days for standard turn around. This should make the analytical data available sometime the week of January 18, 1999. Assuming the analytical data is delivered during the week of January 18, that only leaves a week to complete the assessment report. Accordingly, I would like to request an extension to complete the assessment report until March 1, 1999.
