3. **FACTS:** For the reporting period of February 1, 2020, through April 30, 2020, the Office of Environmental Affairs issued one hundred thirty-nine (139) Consent Orders with total assessed civil penalties in the amount of two hundred fifty-nine thousand, nineteen dollars (\$259,019.00). Also, thirty (30) Administrative Orders were reported during this period with total assessed civil penalties in the amount of seventy-six thousand, six hundred twelve dollars (\$76,612.00).

The Individual/Entity has violated the SUPERB Act and the South Carolina Underground Storage Tank Regulation, as follows: failed to operate and maintain corrosion protection equipment continuously; failed to inspect the impressed current system every sixty (60) days; failed to validate that monthly requirements have been met; and failed to have properly trained Class C operator before assuming the duties of a Class C operator.

Action: The Individual/Entity is required to submit: proof that a Class A/B operator log is being properly maintained; proof that Class C operators have been trained and designated for the Facility; proof that the exposed wiring from the impressed current system has been buried; proof that an impressed current rectifier log is being properly maintained; and pay a civil penalty in the amount of two thousand, eight hundred fifty dollars (**\$2,850.00**).

Action: The Individual/Entity is required to: submit a completed Certificate of Financial Responsibility form and evidence of financial assurance; pay annual tank registration fees and associated late fees for fiscal years 2017, 2018, 2019, and 2020 in the amount of two thousand, four hundred twenty dollars (\$2,420.00); submit a completed Tank and Sludge form for the permanent closure of the UST at the Facility or submit proof that UST metal integrity/viability testing has been initiated; and pay a civil penalty in the amount of eleven thousand, six hundred fifty dollars (**\$11,650.00**).
