**Announcement of Record of Decision and
Update of Administrative Record**

The South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (“DHEC”) approved the Remedial Action Record of Decision (“ROD”) on May 3, 2007 for the Former Florence MGP Site (“Site”). The Site’s ROD explains, among other things, the Department’s selected cleanup alternative. DHEC will oversee the removal of contaminated soils, the treatment of offsite groundwater, and the monitoring of groundwater in and around the Site. Deed restrictions will be placed on the property, which will limit the future reuse of the Site property. SCANA Services, Inc. will develop the Remedial Design, which will detail the step-by-step activities outlined in the ROD. The actual onsite cleanup activities are expected to begin in September 2007.

DHEC further announces that the Administrative Record for the Site will be updated to include the ROD, which will be available at the Florence County Library at 509 South Dargan Street, Florence, SC, on or around May 11, 2007.
